2. Short description of the tool

Word Scramble is an online worksheet generator that automatically mixes up letters in a random fashion and generates a worksheet with letter spaces for the correct spelling of each word. The learner has to rearrange the letters, presented horizontally, to spell the words correctly.

Word Scramble is usually used in language classes (mother tongue or second language learning) when a certain topic has been covered, e.g. as a revision and consolidation of the target vocabulary. This type of activity is also very efficient in literacy classes.

The level of difficulty can be adapted according to the learners' language skills level. This tool offers three possibilities in terms of challenge - you can give an initial character, you can give no initial character or you can also give 25% of the characters to the learner. In total, you can list up to 26 words. Learners can work either individually or in pairs to solve the anagrams.

4. The requirements concerning the tool

Word Scramble can be used as a free online tool by language teachers. To do this, one only has to register with an email address. A language teacher can generate an account in which he/she can find all the worksheets which have been saved and further edit or reuse them. In the free version, however, the language teacher can only save 10 printable worksheets. The storage capacity can be extended to up to 1000 or 3000 worksheets if one opts for a paid versions (i.e. a 'premium' or 'pro' version).

5. Language of the tool

The default language for the tool is English. Nevertheless, language teachers may use it for different languages, even though the target language has specific diacritics such as German, Romanian, French or Czech.


8. How can the tool be used by teachers/learners?

This tool can be used by language teachers to generate worksheets to:

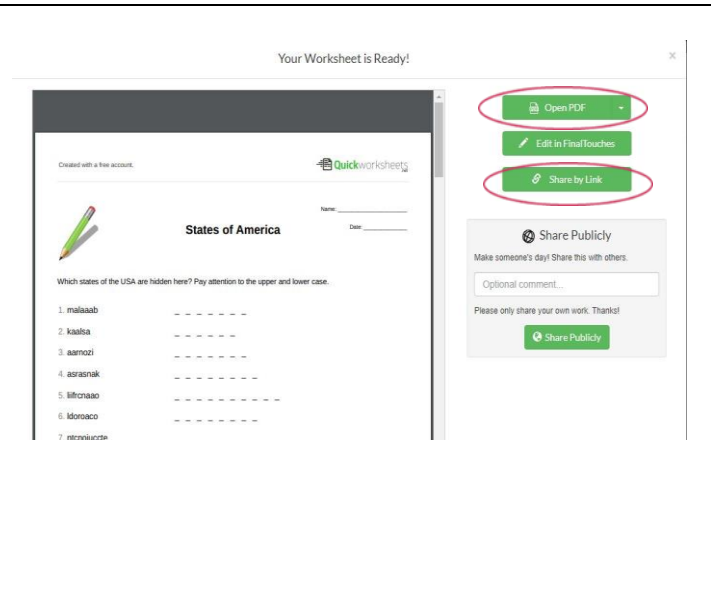
- Practise the correct spelling of newly learned words.

- Make vocabulary learning and revising more engaging
- Practise orthography, e.g. upper and lower case spelling.

9. Case study – example

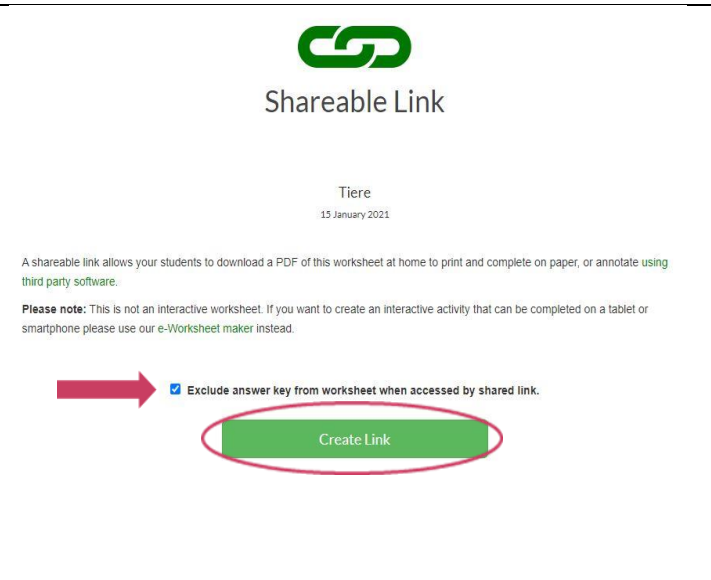
<p>1. Write the title and the instructions for the assignment.</p>	
<p>2. Enter the words from a text file or simply by typing. For English lessons, you can select a word list on a topic available on the platform.</p>	
<p>3. The difficulty level can be adjusted by adding some hints depending on your learners' level. For beginners, even a word bank can be added.</p>	

<p>4. You can also choose between lowercase and uppercase.</p>	<p>4. Scrambled Word Letter Case:</p> 
<p>5. The layout of the worksheet or the arrangement of the words can also be chosen. Furthermore, you can click on Add a Writing Exercise button.</p>	<p>5. Number of Columns:</p>

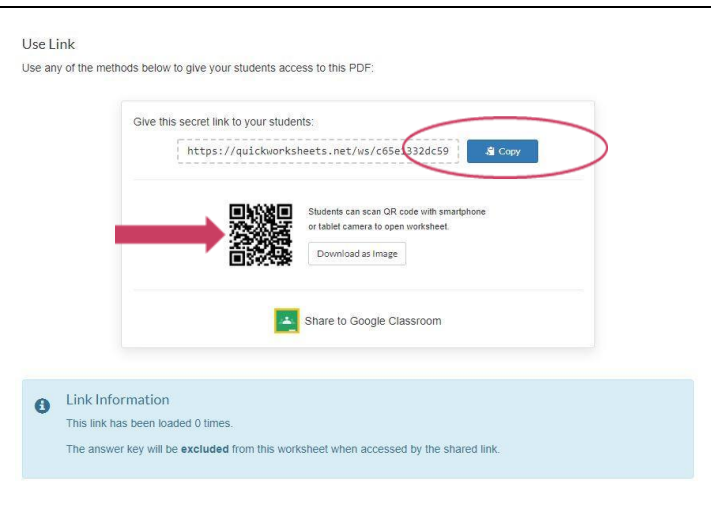
7. Click on the **Open PDF** button to save the worksheet on your PC or print it. If you have requested the answer key, you will now receive it together with the worksheet. You can also share the worksheet directly with your learners by clicking on the **Share by Link** button.



8. By clicking on the **Create Link** and ticking **Exclude answer key** from the worksheet when accessed by link, you can send the link directly to your learners.



9. The shared link allows your learners to download the worksheet and complete it on paper. There is also the option to scan the **QR code** and open the worksheet.





10. Things you have to bear in mind when using the tool

- You can use this tool free of charge, but you have to register first. The signup process only takes a few seconds.
- This tool is designed for printed versions only.
- It can be used for different languages, even if the target language has special characters.
- The complexity level can be adjusted accordingly by adding/removing hints.
